

Bengaluru Summit 2025

Purpose

To bring Indian Inkscape contributors in a single place and collaborate on things each of us are working independently. We'll also have a booth at [IndiaFOSS 2025](#), attendance of which will be optional.

Short Summary

Dates: 15 – 21 September 2025 (Total 7 days – 4 days Summit + 3 days Conference)

Expected number of participants: 5

Expected total cost: \$2575

Venue for the summit

It's a really nice co-working space, 10 minutes walk from Zostel Kormangala. It also has conference rooms available.

Stay Options

[Zostel Kormangala](#)

- 4.9 kms from NIMHANS (10 mins by car in good Bengaluru traffic)
- 6 bed dorm (shared) – 1038 INR (\$12) per night per person

[Hosteller Brigade Road](#)

- 3.6 kms from NIMHANS (10 mins by car in good Bengaluru traffic)
- Double beds – 2487 INR (\$25) per night (/2 per person if shared with someone)
- 4 bed dorm (shared) – 794 INR (\$8.50) per night per person

Cost breakup

Travel and stay (per person for all 7 days):

- A1.** Flights: 12000 INR (\$140) (round trip)
- A2.** Stay: 7000 INR (\$81)
- A3.** Food: 7000 INR (\$81)
- A4.** Intercity travel: 3000 INR (\$35)
- A5.** Conference ticket: 3000 INR (\$35) (optional to attend)

Travel and stay Cost (A) = (A1 + A2 + A3 + A4 + A5) * 5 = 32000 INR (\$370) * 5 = 160000 INR (\$1850)

Summit Venue Cost:

Option 1 (B): 4 Day Pass (5 People) without conference room = 17700 INR (\$204)

Option 2 (C): Conference Room (6 People) = 14160 INR (\$164) per day * 4 days = 56640 INR (\$655)

Other Costs (D):

Screen for booth at the conference – 5900 INR (\$70)

Final cost:

(A) + max(B, C) + (D) = 1850 + 655 + 70 = \$2575 (222,938 INR)

Criteria to attend

Every Indian [Inkscape member](#) may join. All sorts of contributors are welcome, and the success of the Summit will depend on a diverse set of participants!

In case I receive more applications than the hotel venue has space, I will have to prioritize those who have contributed recently – but I don't expect that to happen.
